In 2026, The Empire will present & JULIET – a coming-of-age jukebox musical which features the music of Swedish pop songwriter Max Martin and a book by David West Read which began in London's West End, then moved over to Broadway in 2022 where it received 9 Tony Award nominations, including Best Musical for the 2022-2023 season.

Created by the Emmy-winning writer from *Schitt's Creek* this hilarious new musical flips the script on the greatest love story ever told. & *JULIET* asks: what would happen next if Juliet didn't end it all over Romeo? - 6. Effective in working positively with volunteers of diverse skills, fostering a supportive and inclusive production atmosphere.
